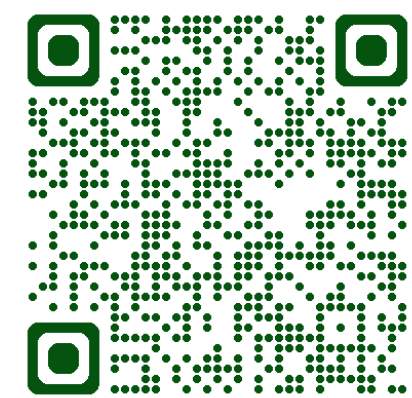


You found a butternut!
