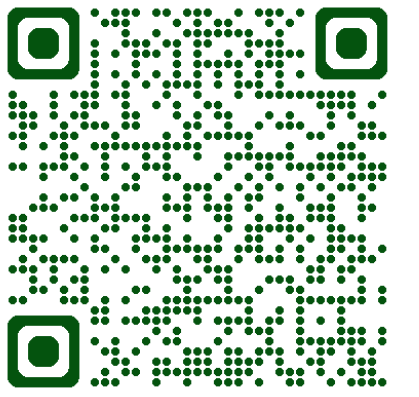


You found a Kentucky coffeetree!
