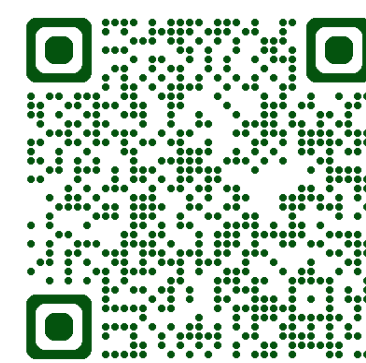


You found a butternut!

Scientific name: *Juglans cinerea*



Butternut, also known as white walnut, is native in Eastern Kentucky, but is a **rare find**

Its distinctive **light grey bark** distinguishes it from the black walnut
